Calgary Family Law Associates High School Mixed Media Competition 2021

Topic: How does Systemic Racism Impact an Individual's Ability to Access Justice?

In connection with the Youth Leaders in Law YYC Conference 2021, Calgary Family Law Associates (CFLA) is sponsoring a competition for high school students to submit a piece of personal work on the topic of "How does systemic racism impact an individual's ability to access justice?".

Canada's access to civil justice has been ranked ninth out of 12 European and North American countries. We still have a long way to go in many aspects. Canada's Department of Justice released a report in 2019 that shares the four biggest problems regarding access to justice; underreporting due to scared victims, trial delays, bad treatment within the system, and the lack of affordable and timely support/resources.

According to a 2019 study done by the Canada Race Relations Foundation, Indigenous Peoples and Black people are the most common targets of discrimination and unfair treatment in Canada, followed by Muslims and people from the Middle East.

This discrimination may mean that people have less access to some services, such as healthcare, jobs, and justice.¹

Monetary prizes will be awarded at the Conference for the top 3 entries as follows: 1^{st} prize - \$300, 2^{nd} prize - \$150, and 3^{rd} prize - \$50.

Submissions may be made by any high school student in Canada in their choice of media: essay, poem, story, script, art, video. Written entries must be 5 pages or less. Video entries must be 5 minutes or less.

Submissions will be judged anonymously by CFLA lawyers. Winning entries may be posted online and may receive the opportunity to have their work displayed at the Canadian Bar Association's Access to Justice Displays at City Hall or elsewhere.
